Well, from my experience of the world, I would argue that the majority of problems faced by humanity at the moment are largely due to overpopulation. I would point to the "mouse utopia" experiments conducted by Calhoun, where he found very noticeable social problems, termed as a behavioural sink, in mice when they were presented with a scenario where they had unlimited food and water, no predators, and limited space. Consistently his "mouse utopias" eventually collapsed under the weight of social problems that led to the complete extinction of the mouse population within his experiment. Similarly we are, as a species in perhaps an even direr situation. With nothing to curb our population growth we have found ourselves in a scenario with a population that is growing beyond any reasonably sustainable amount. This is a serious concern because regardless of how quickly we adapt, to lessen our impact on the planet we run a very real risk of running out of the resources required to ensure the survival of our species on this planet before we have sustainable life on other planets. I propose that as a species we must make concerted efforts to decrease our population growth through social means. China had its heart in the right place when it mandated that its people could only have one child, but that policy clearly misunderstood that the only lasting change must be brought about through either social means, or through violent means.
